



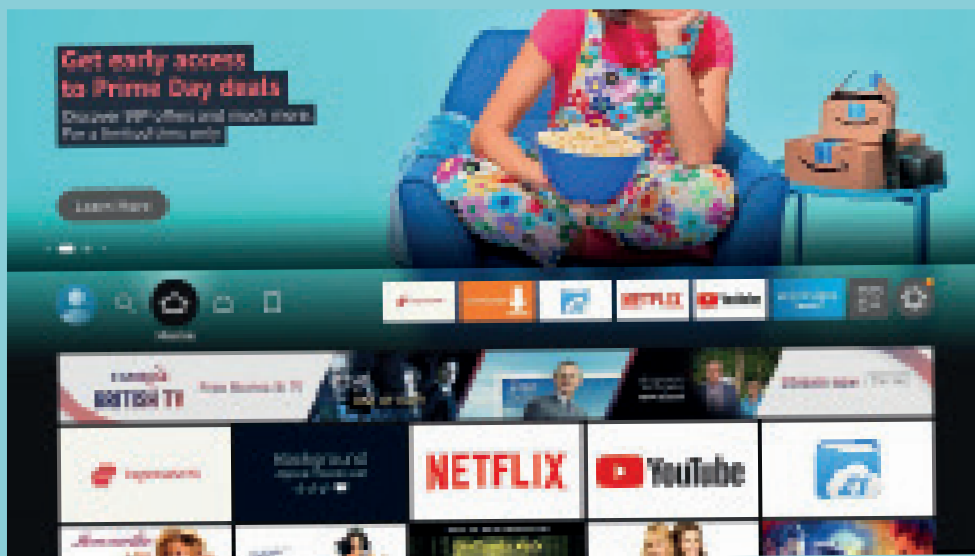
SET UP INSTRUCTIONS

HOW TO JAILBREAK FIRESTICK

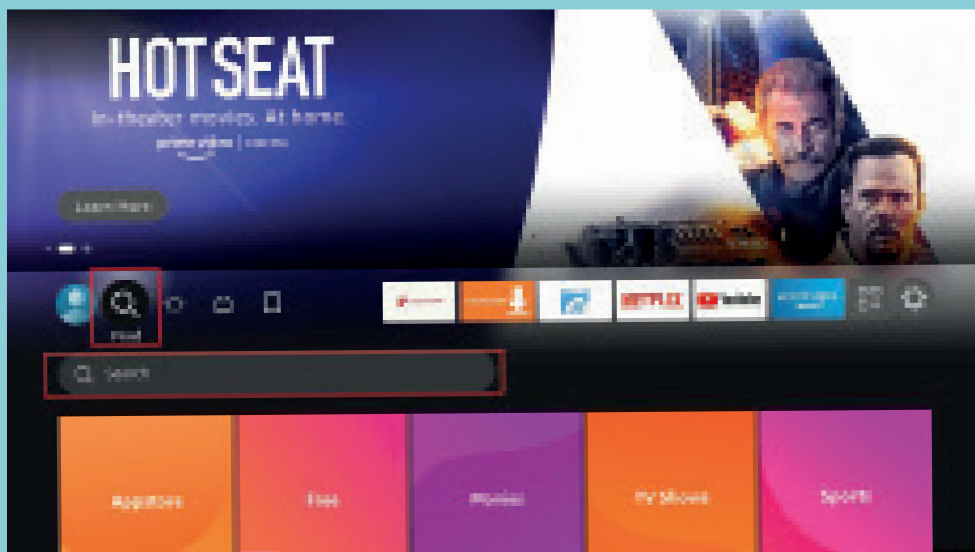
Set up your Firestick as per instructions on screen.

1. Go to the home screen of your Amazon Fire TV Stick.

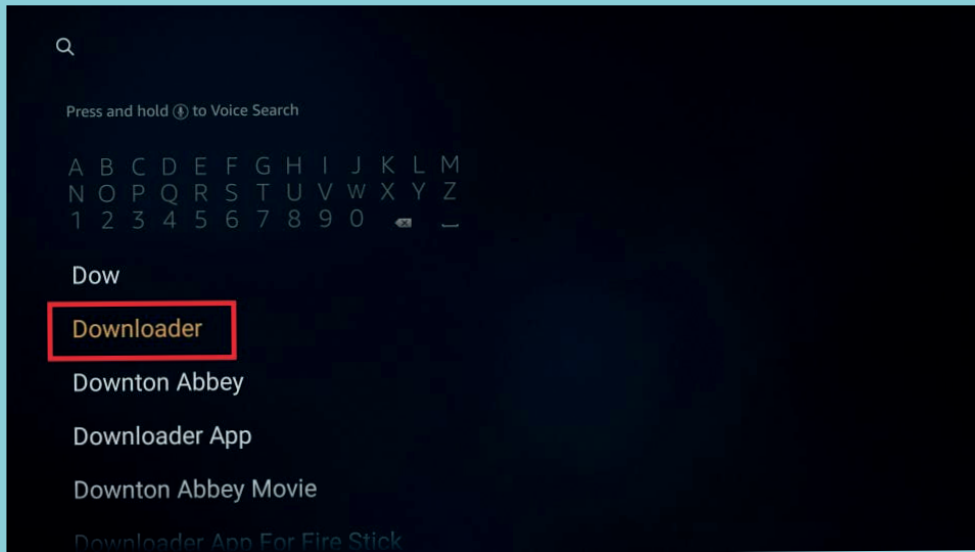
Note: depending on your Fire TV OS version, your home screen may appear a little different.



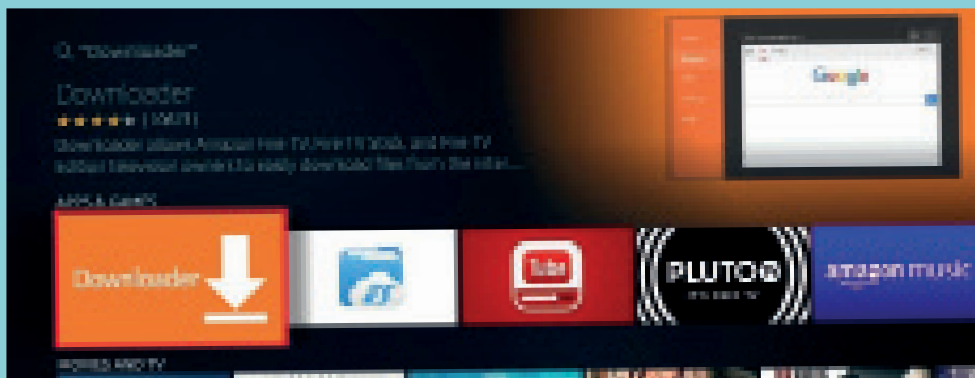
2. Select **Find** in the middle bar followed by **Search**.



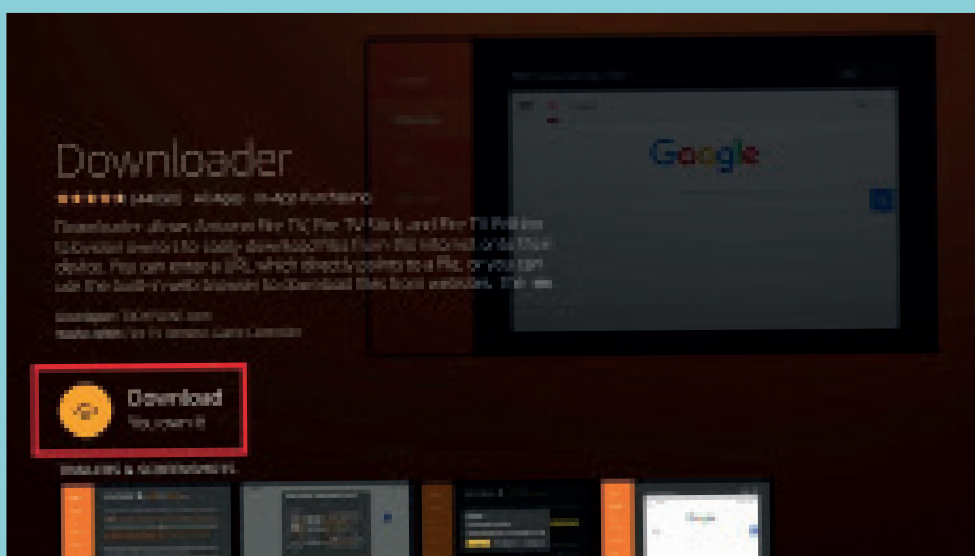
3. On the search window, type the name of the app, **Downloader**. Click **Downloader** in the search suggestions.



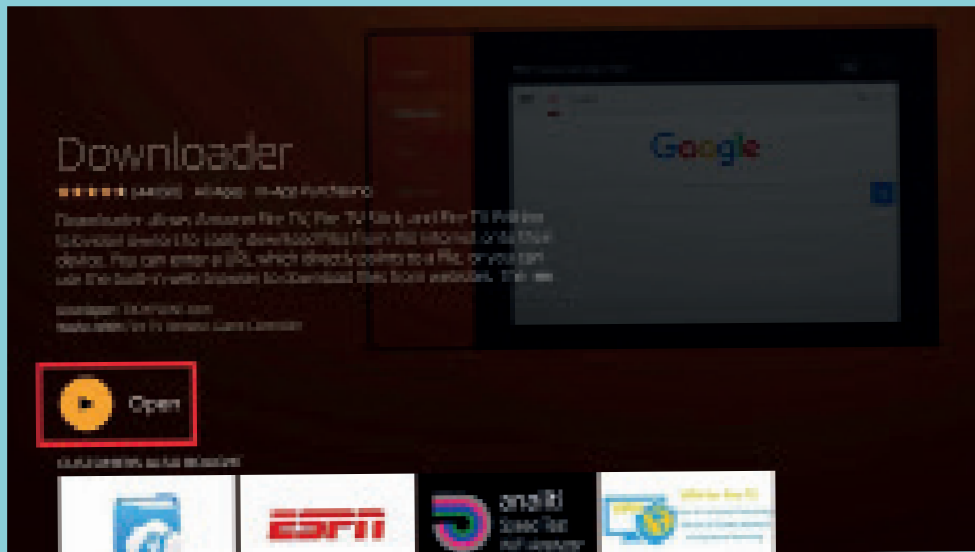
4. Click the **Downloader** icon on the next screen.



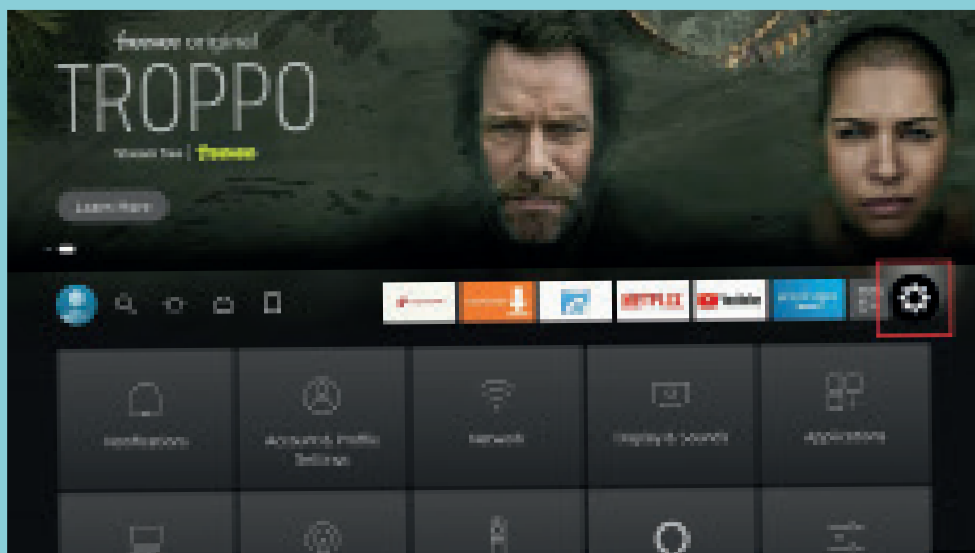
5. Choose **Download** (or **Get**) on the window that appears next.



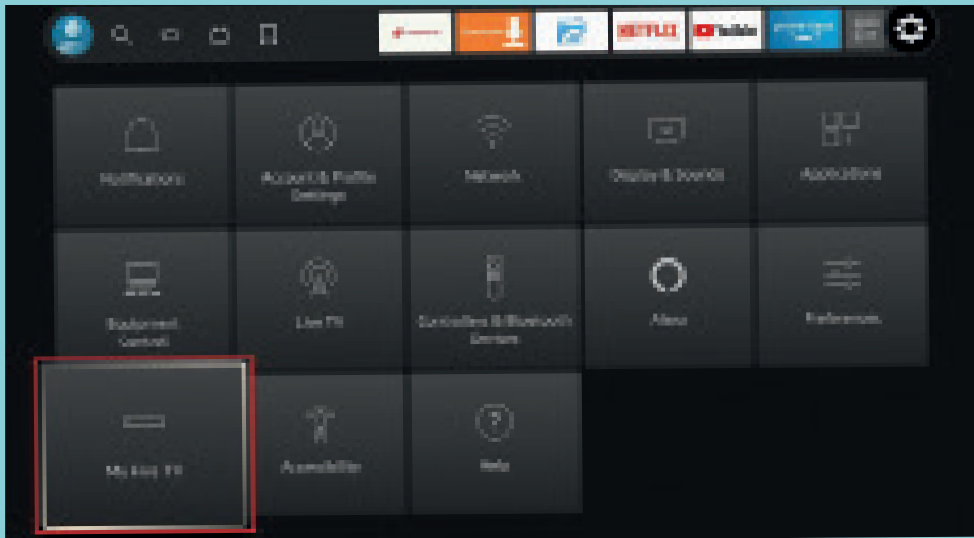
6. Wait for the Downloader app to download and then install. Then click **Open** to launch the Downloader app.



7. Dismiss any prompts that are displayed when you use the **Downloader** app for the first time. But if it asks you to give it any permissions, make sure you **Allow** them all. Go back out of **Downloader** app and back to the home screen.
8. Select the gear or cog icon in the middle bar (on the far right) to open **Settings**.

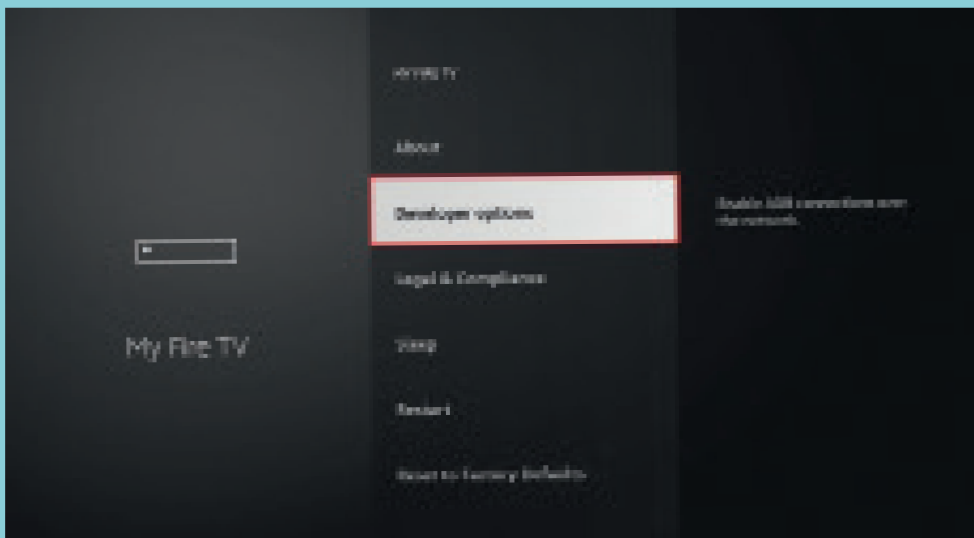


9. Now, choose the option **My Fire TV**.

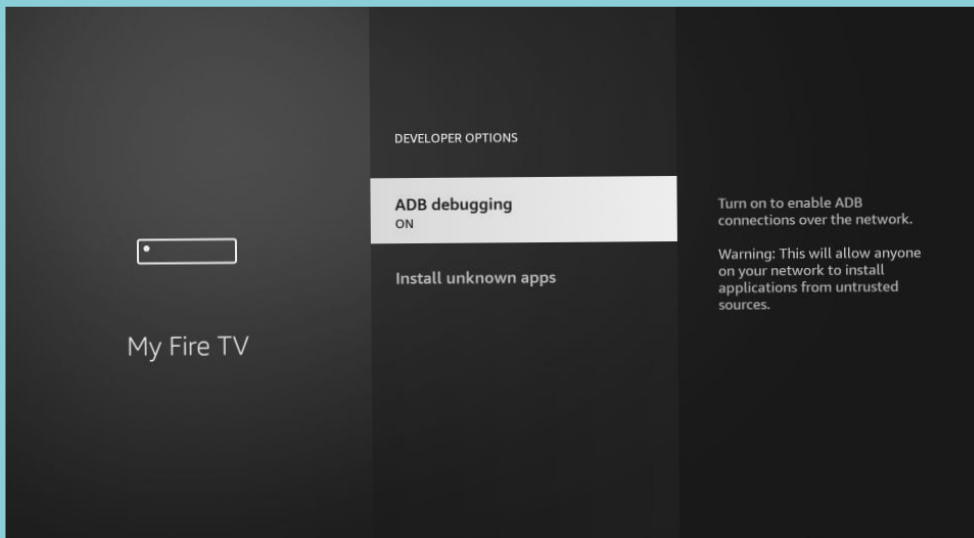


10. On the following window, click **Developer options**.
(**Note:** If you don't see **Developer options**, go back to **Settings > My Fire TV > About**. Now, select **Fire TV Stick** and click it **7 times** to enable **Developer options**).

Go back to the previous window and you will see **Developer options** now.

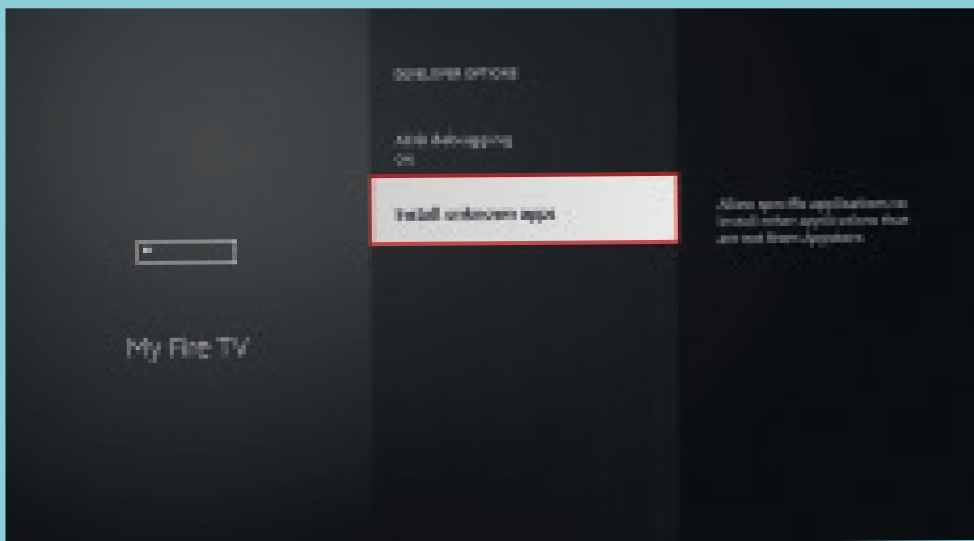


11. First, switch **ON** the **ADB Debugging**.

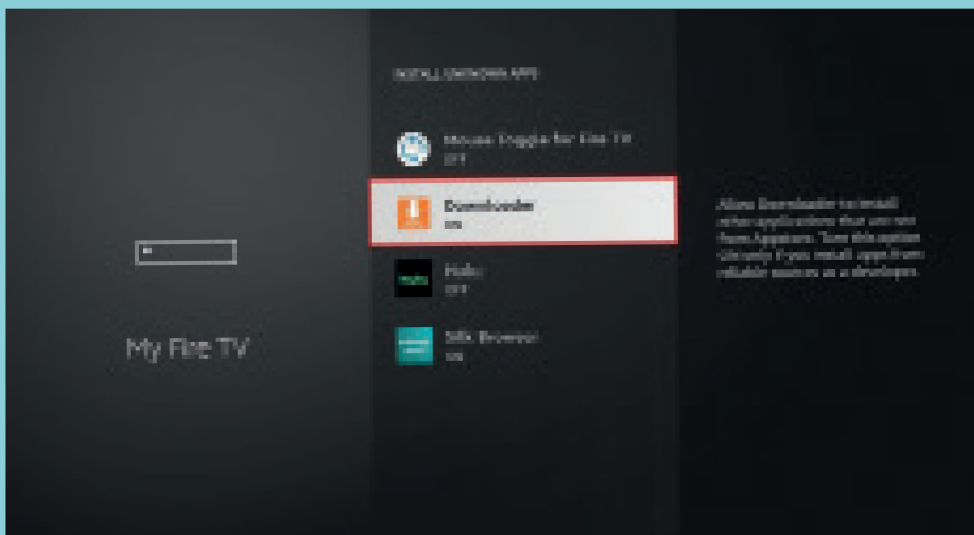


12. Next, click **Install unknown apps**. This setting gives you permission to download apps from outside the Amazon App Store.

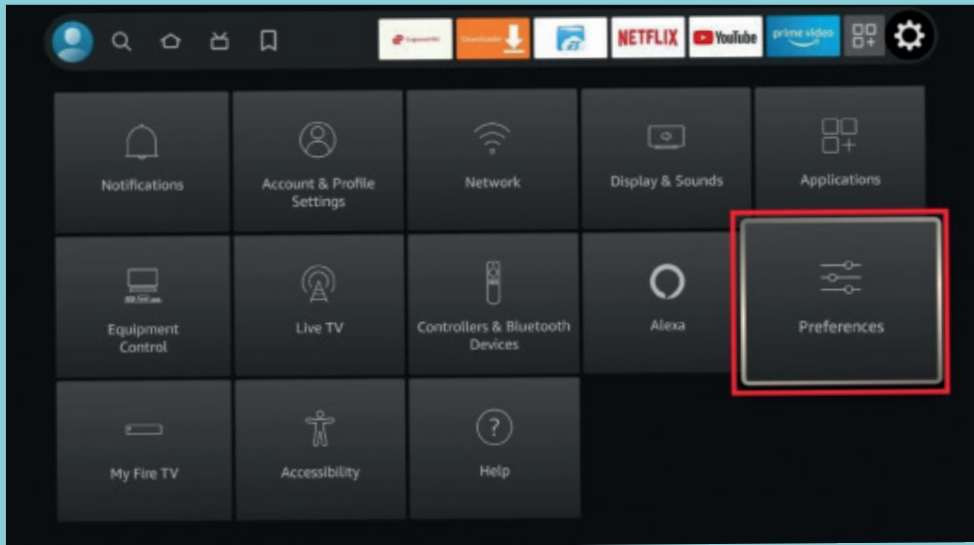
Note: On the older Fire TV OS, click **Apps from unknown sources** and turn it **ON**.



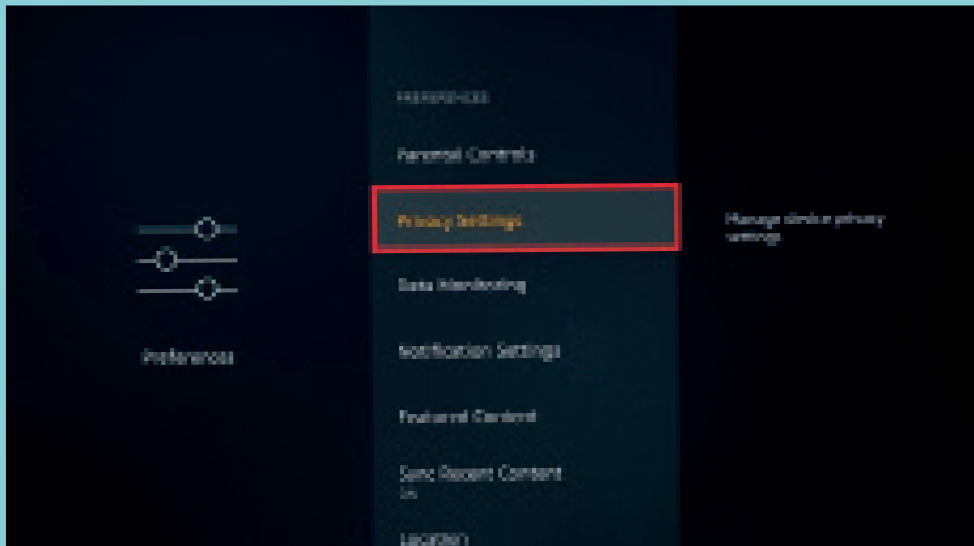
13. Click **Downloader** and turn it **ON**.



14. Press the **back button** on the Amazon Fire TV remote. It will take you back to the Settings window. Open **Preferences**.

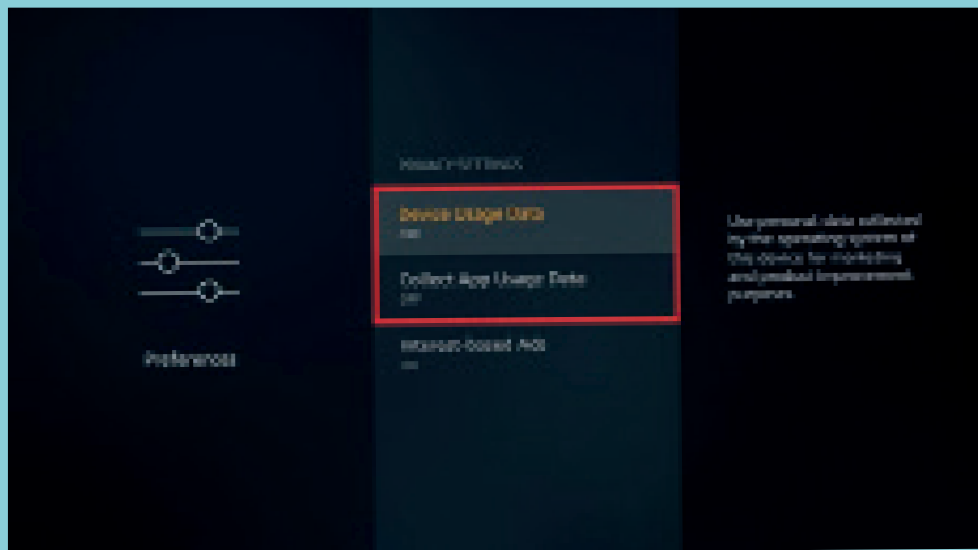


15. Open **Privacy Settings**.



16. Turn **OFF** the following options to stop sharing the usage data in the Privacy Settings:

- Device Usage Data
- Collect App Usage Data



17. Now, turn **OFF** the **Data Monitoring** setting on the previous screen.
